O. F. Russel has filed a suit in equity against the **Euclid Oil and Gas Co.** and a subpoena duces tecum has been issued on the **Lincoln National**, the **Duquesne** and the **Peoples National** banks of **Pittsburg** to appear in court on **March 12th** with all papers and books etc. showing or in any way relating to transactions with the **Euclid Oil and Gas Co.**: **M. L. Zahnizer**, **H. B. Zahnizer** and **Jno. Rusb.**—The plaintiff in the case is a member of the **Euclid Oil Co.**, doing business at **West Sunbury**. The company is capitalized at **\$35,000**, divided into **350** shares of **\$100** each. The **East End Oil Company** composed of **M. L. Zahnizer**, **H. B. Zahnizer** and **J. R. Rush**, of **Pittsburg**, is the owner of **225** Shares of the stock. The president of the **Euclid Oil Co.** is **W. G. Russel**, of **West Sunbury**; the secretary is **M. L. Zahnizer**, and the treasurer **H. B. Zahnizer**. The plaintiff alleges that **M. L. Zahnizer** and **N. B. Zahnizer** have been fraudulently diverted the assets and the money in the treasury of the **Euclid Oil Company** to the use and benefit of the **East End Oil Company** and asks the court to grant an injunction to restrain the **Euclid Oil and Gas Co.** from further waste of its assets and command the **East End Oil Co.** to restore to the **Euclid Oil Company** the money wrongfully received and also appoint a receiver for the **Euclid Oil Co.**

Orphan's Court.

A decree of court has been issued in the estate of **George List** authorizing the administrator, **Margaret A. List** to issue a mortgage for **\$750** on real estate described in the petition.
A decree was granted in the estate of **George Marburger**, dec'd, of **Andrus township**, authorizing the executors,
